

The problem with driving under the influence is... ...the MOURNING after!

April 24, 2016 ¹

A man was booked on suspicion of gross vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated and DUI causing injury or death in connection with a multi-vehicle crash killing a Rancho Cordova resident, while aiding his wife as her vehicle ran out of gas.

July 29, 2016 ²

Drunk man slammed into a pole killing his male friend in the passenger seat and leaving a female passenger on life support in Santa Ana, CA.

August 20, 2016 ³

A mother and her two daughters, an 8-year old and 5-year old, were involved in a fatal crash with an intoxicated man after leaving a birthday party in Placentia, CA.

September 3, 2016 ⁴

A woman was charged with a DUI and a hit-and-run that killed a 15-month baby and seriously injuring a teenager who was pushing the stroller near a crosswalk in Hawthorne, CA.

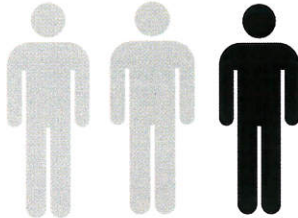

CA Vehicle Code §23152(a)(e)

Drug-involved crash fatalities have increased by 54% since 2003.

Be Aware

Driving under the influence (DUI) is a crime that impacts innocent victims, the offenders, their families, and the community.



CA Vehicular Crimes and Penalties

Criminal consequences for a DUI can include a criminal record, murder, incarceration, suspension/revocation of a driver's license, legal and attorney fees, participation in a state licensed DUI program, and additional requirements varying by each County.

Financial Impact

The average cost for a DUI first offense can range from \$3,500 to \$25,000 or more depending on legal and attorney fees.

- ⇒ Web-based/online DUI programs are not recognized by the DMV and does not meet the California requirements.
- ⇒ California's DUI treatment system is 100% self-funded by program fees paid by the participants. (San Diego County DUI Symposium, 2016)
