CADTP is one of the SUD counselor certifying organizations recognized by the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Compliance Division. As required in California regulations, all California SUD counselor certification organizations must be accredited by the Institute for Credentialing Excellence (ICE), a part of the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA).

The CADTP Substance Use Disorder Certified Counselor (SUDCC) credential is accredited by NCCA/ICE and is recognized by DHCS. Those certified or registered under this credential are authorized to work in any substance use disorder (SUD) treatment modality certified or licensed by DHCS.

Individuals providing counseling services in state-certified or licensed SUD treatment programs must be registered and then subsequently certified within 5 years of commencing such services. After certification, individuals are required to complete 40 continuing education units/hours (CEU'S) and renew their certification every 2 years. Up to 12.25 CEU'S are available at this forum, up to .75 hours apply to Clinical Supervision and 1.5 hours apply to Ethics and Confidentiality. More Information is available at www.cadtp.org.
